

# CROSSWINDS AVIATION SYLLABUS GUIDE

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The Crosswinds Aviation syllabus is a tool to provide structure on your way to achieve your FAA Private Pilot license or additional FAA rating. The most important element of efficient training is knowing what your next lessons are and coming prepared for them. This is because the learning curve is so much higher when you study and come prepared. So with the objective of minimizing cost and time, we expect that you follow these steps to keep your training as efficient as possible.

- Complete the required pre-study material prior to each lesson utilizing the resources as specified by the Crosswinds Aviation syllabus.
- At the beginning of each lesson a pre-lesson quiz will be administered to see if you have studied the material that is going to be covered.
- A fail on the quiz will result in the instructor logging a “strike” indicating that the student did not study prior to the lesson.
- After “3 strikes” have been logged the Crosswinds staff will reach out to assess and discuss your flight training. This is to help us identify and resolve any issues that might keep you from moving forward in your training, and find solutions to help you keep your training hours and costs within our estimated figures. We will also make a determination at this time if cost and time to complete is a relevant factor for the student. If it’s determined that it is not, then we may agree to change expectations between the student and Crosswinds Aviation accordingly.

Here is how our instructors plan on using the training syllabus:

- The syllabus has two types of training tasks; introduction and review.
- Introduction items will be checked off when the instructor has taught the material related to the task.
- Review items will be checked off when the student demonstrates the required proficiency of the task.
- Items that are not checked off will also have the reason written down in the notes as to why the items are not being checked off (the reasons that you are not demonstrating proficiency yet, couldn't fit the task into the lesson, etc). These notes will be used by your instructors to figure out how to tailor the student’s upcoming lessons and training specifically to you.
- While the syllabus is a great tool, each student’s “road map” will look different getting to their goal and will be tailored specifically to them as the coursework progresses. The instructors may add extra lessons, combine lessons, or tailor lessons to fit the specific need of the student.
